

LOCATION

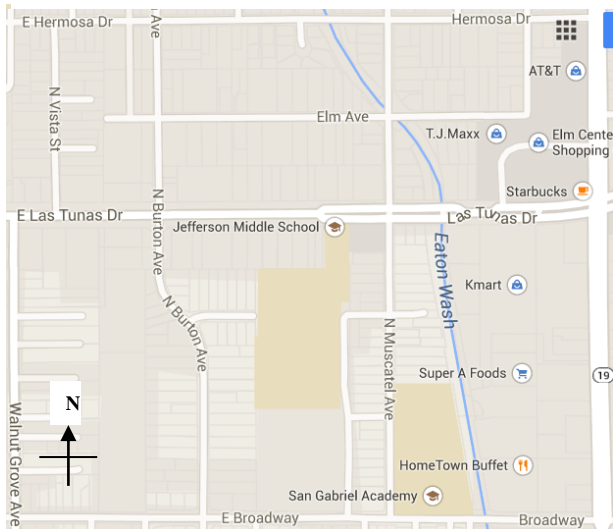
Jefferson Middle School is located at:

1372 East Las Tunas Drive
San Gabriel, CA 91776

Conveniently located on Las Tunas Drive, East of Walnut Grove Avenue (east of San Gabriel Blvd.), West of Muscatel Avenue (west of Rosemead Blvd.), and North of the I-10.

Most instruction will take place on the north side of the school campus, before the "B" building. Main entrance to the school is located off the southwest corner of the north parking lot. This walkway along the school administration building allows access to all classrooms.

Parking is available on the north and along the east side of the campus. Parking ends at the gate to the athletic field on the south side.

MISSION

The Saturday Conservatory of Music was established to provide affordable, quality music instruction to children in the greater Los Angeles area, primarily targeting children from low-income families who are school-trained music students.

HISTORY

In 1966, music coordinator of the East Los Angeles region of the Los Angeles Unified School District, Carl Bruce with his music teacher wife, Ellen, and Robert Runge, Professor of Music Education at California State University, Los Angeles, organized the Cal State L.A. Saturday Conservatory of Music. The purpose of the Conservatory was, and still is, to provide an affordable, more individualized musical experience than is offered in public school music programs. Instrumental and vocal classes are taught in small groups by specialists who are trained music educators.

Theory

These classes are designed to help students

FEES

Tuition \$120 per quarter
Registration \$10 per quarter (non-
refundable)

OTHER FEES

- \$5 per student discount for siblings
- \$50 for orchestra only (plus registration fee).
\$40 for additional ensemble class. Available
ONLY to students taking private lessons.
- \$10 for each additional orchestra or ensemble
- \$40 for each additional instrument
- \$10 for late registration
- 50% off tuition for SGUSD students *subject to
verification*

EXPECTATIONS

- It is mandatory for each student to have an
instrument(s) to practice on.
- Each student must bring their instrument(s) to
class.
- Attendance is mandatory.
- Missed classes will result in being dropped
from the class.
- Practice is mandatory – 20 to 30 minutes per
day per instrument is the minimum.
- Unruly or destructive behavior will result in
removal from the program without refund.

ELIGIBILITY

Students between the ages of 6 and 20 (4 to 7
for Music Jungle) may attend this music
program. *The Conservatory strongly supports
school music programs. Conservatory
students are required to participate in their
respective school music programs if available.*
